


Saturday, May 13th is Boulder City's Historic Preservation Day 2023!

April is National Safe Digging Month

Getting ready for Spring projects around the house? Make sure you “Know what’s below. Call before you dig.” By calling 811, homeowners and contractors are connected to USA North, Nevada’s 811 call center. USA North notifies the appropriate utility companies of the project site. Professional locators will mark the approximate locations of underground lines with flags, paint or both. Homeowners should:



**Know what's below.
Call before you dig.**

- Call 811 three to five business days before digging, regardless of depth.
- Confirm that all lines have been marked.
- Consider moving the location of your project if it is near utility line markings.
- If hiring a contractor, confirm that the contractor has called 811. Don't allow work to begin if the lines aren't marked.

It's free. It's easy. It's the law. Call before you dig!

Get Smart Irrigation - Get a Rebate!

The Smart Irrigation Controller Rebate Program is available to all Boulder City residential utility customers. Rebate amounts are \$75 per controller or fifty percent off the MSRP, whichever is less. This is in addition to the rebate that the [Southern Nevada Watering Authority](#) (SNWA) offers. The following eligibility requirements apply:



- The system must be in an existing home in the Boulder City electric service territory.
- Complete and submit the rebate application form within 90 days of installation.
- Provide a dated contractor invoice, if a contractor was used.
- Applicants may be subject to an on-site inspection by a Boulder City representative to verify equipment is properly installed and operational.
