




Be Summer Smart: Use Technology to Save Energy

When Boulder City utility customers use more electricity and water, their rates increase into higher tiers. These tiers are designed to encourage customers to conserve electricity and water. Thanks to technology, there are several ways to not just conserve, but even get a rebate for devices that support conservation.



SMART THERMOSTATS

Save electricity and money by investing in a “smart” thermostat. These thermostats will change the temperature of your home in the most efficient way possible and will avoid unnecessary heating and cooling of your home while unoccupied. Rebates are available for Boulder City customers when they replace old thermostats with Smart Thermostats.*

SMART IRRIGATION

The Smart Irrigation Controller Rebate Program is available to all Boulder City residential utility customers. Rebate amounts are \$75 per controller or fifty percent off the MSRP, whichever is less.* This is in addition to the rebate that the Southern Nevada Watering Authority (SNWA) offers.



Other sustainable practices that save energy and water:

- Turn off lights and appliances when not in use
- Keep your thermostat at 78-degrees in the summer months
- Replace air conditioners and appliances with energy-efficient models
- Run your dishwasher, clothes washer and dryer fully loaded when possible to avoid additional use
- Take showers instead of baths and turn off water when brushing teeth
- Install water-efficient emitters for outdoor irrigation
