



RESOURCES FOR TENANTS

Tenants of manufactured home developments, single-family and apartment complexes have resources that they can pursue to seek legal advice and rental subsidies. A summary of those resources are below:

- AG Office Complaint: Tenants can file a complaint with the Nevada attorney general's office at 888-434-9989 or by visiting their website at: [Complaint Form](#).
- Manufactured Home Complaints: Tenants of manufactured homes can email or write a letter to the Nevada Housing Division – Manufactured Housing NHDinfo@housing.nv.gov. All complaints to the Division and are considered confidential. In some cases, mediation may be required by the investigators to resolve the dispute.
- Seek Legal Advice: Tenants can contact Nevada Legal Services at Nevada Legal Services at 702-383-6095 or the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada at 702-386-1070 for guidance.
- Manufactured Home Tenant Housing Assistance: Manufactured home owners can apply for income assistance through the Nevada Housing Division Low Rent Subsidy Program by calling (775) 684- 2940; visit their website at [Manufactured Home Rent Subsidy](#)
- Apartment and Home Rental Financial Assistance: Apply with the Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority for a Housing Choice Voucher by visiting their website at: [SNVRHA Housing Voucher](#) or calling (702) 477-3100.
