TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This permit authorizes the permitted group to voluntarily remove litter, weeds and other debris a minimum of 4 times a year from within CITY OF BOULDER CITY Right-of-Way of the route location designated by this permit subject to the following conditions:

1. The permit shall be signed by PERMITTEE on page 1 and email it to publicworks@bcnv.org. The permit shall not be valid until the signed original permit has been received by the Public Works office.
2. This temporary permit expires three years after the issued date. The PERMITTEE is required to re-apply on a three-year basis.
3. The PERMITTEE agrees to indemnify and save harmless the City of Boulder City and its officers, agents, and employees against any and all liability, loss, damage, costs, fees and expense which it or they may incur, suffer, or be required to pay by reason of death, disease, or bodily injury to any person or persons, or injury to, destruction of, or loss of use of any property, including property belonging to the City of Boulder City, arising out of or incident to activities contemplated by this permit, and proximately caused, in whole or in part, by any act or omission of the PERMITTEE, or its contractors, agents, or the employees of any one or all of them or by the officers, agents, or employees of the state of Nevada, unless it is established by the PERMITTEE that the proximate cause was the willful misconduct or gross negligence of the officers, agents, or employees of the City of Boulder City.
4. The PERMITTEE acknowledges the hazardous nature of the work and efforts involved in contributing toward the effort of maintaining litter-free streetscapes. More specifically, cleanup work can be in rough or treacherous areas, occasionally near vehicle traffic. Participants also may encounter unexpected and unidentified hazardous materials, which should not be touched but should be brought to CITY OF BOULDER CITY's attention. The PERMITTEE and its members acknowledge and assumes these risks.
5. The PERMITTEE shall obtain required supplies and materials from the CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office at 702-293-9266, Monday-Thursday, 7am-3pm, and must notify CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office five (5) working days in advance of right of way activity. PERMITTEE shall not occupy right of way on any state observed holiday and may occupy right of way on weekends that are not holidays.
6. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons working in the public Right-of-Way execute a "Declaration of Participant" form, of which is attached as "Exhibit A".
7. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons working in the public Right-of-Way wear OSHA approved reflective clothes, not limited to hats and vests and stay a reasonable and safe distance from passing traffic at all times. Up to twenty (20) reflective vests will be issued to the PERMITTEE upon receipt of the signed "Declaration of Participant" form from each member of the PERMITTEE's group. Quantities of bags provided for trash removal shall be issued on a case-by-case basis.
8. The PERMITTEE shall ensure that permit activities are ceased in the event of forecasted inclement weather conditions.



9. The PERMITTEE shall notify the CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office of any unusual circumstances, such as when large, heavy, or hazardous items are found, and it will be the DEPARTMENT's responsibility to remove such items from the adopted section.
10. PERMITTEE shall notify the CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office during regular business hours to coordinate the removal of bagged trash when needed. Please be prepared to provide your name, contact number, permit number, route, segment, number of bags and location of the bags. Place bags in a location that is easily accessible for CITY OF BOULDER CITY Maintenance staff.
11. The PERMITTEE shall notify the DEPARTMENT of any change in PERMITTEE Coordinator during the term of this permit. PERMITTEE Coordinators shall notify their CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office when their group has picked up litter.
12. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons working in the public Right-of-Way become familiar with and comply with the CITY OF BOULDER CITY Safety Requirements for Participants, attached hereto, and incorporated herein as "Exhibit B".
13. The DEPARTMENT shall erect a sign at the beginning of the adopted section with the PERMITTEE's organization name displayed.
14. If, in the sole judgement of the CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office, it is found that the PERMITTEE is not meeting the terms and conditions of this permit, the CITY OF BOULDER CITY Public Works Office may revoke this permit and remove the PERMITTEE's sign.

This temporary right-of-way permit is granted to the PERMITTEE in accordance with the provisions of city and state laws, and subject to the terms and conditions stipulated to perform the work described.

Exhibit B

CITY OF BOULDER CITY ADOPT-A-STREETScape PROGRAM SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS

While on the roadside remember: **SAFETY FIRST!!!**

Please distribute this information to all persons working within CITY OF BOULDER CITY

Right-of-Way To protect yourself and others:

- **Carpool to the site to reduce the number of vehicles and park all vehicles well clear of the roadway. Park your vehicles on the same side of the cleanup area.**
- **Wear CITY OF BOULDER CITY approved safety clothes whenever you are on CITY OF BOULDER CITY's Right-of-Way.**
- **Stay off** the main traveled way of the roadway. Maintain a safe distance from passing vehicles.
- **Do not** attempt to cross traffic lanes on foot. Use crosswalks and signals where available.
- **Always face oncoming traffic as you work and keep an eye on traffic.** Be prepared to move quickly if necessary.
- **Do not use electronic devices such as music players that may interfere with hearing and warnings.**
- **Stay clear** of maintenance or construction activities.
- **Conduct cleanups on one side** of the roadway at a time.
- **Work** during daylight hours only. **Discontinue** work before dusk.
- **Do not** attempt to work when fog or other conditions reduce visibility for drivers.
- **Discontinue** work in inclement weather. **Do not** attempt to work when roadway is icy or wet.
- **Do not** touch or attempt to remove materials that may be toxic or hazardous. Items to avoid include powders, chemicals, smelly substances, suspicious packages, chemical drums or containers, weapons, syringes or hypodermic needles, dead animals, and broken glass. **Immediately notify CITY OF BOULDER CITY at 702-293-9266 or the police of the location of weapons or suspected toxic substances.**
- **Do not** try to compact trash bags. Injuries from broken or jagged objects may occur.
- **Long pants and substantial leather shoes or boots with ankle support are suggested.** Watch your footing and avoid steep slopes, drainage facilities, or places from which you might fall. Light-colored clothing, long-sleeved shirts, and sunscreen lotion are recommended.
- **Do not** run, throw objects, or engage in horseplay or any activity that may distract drivers.
- **Avoid overexertion.** Drink plenty of water, especially on warm, humid days.
- **Do not** consume alcoholic beverages or drugs before entering, or while on, the roadside.
- **Be alert** for snake dens, poisonous plants, and stinging insects. Listen carefully for possible swarms of bees. If you suspect a beehive, leave the area immediately and alert CITY OF BOULDER CITY of the situation.
