## Police Department Seeks Volunteers

Boulder City Police Volunteers are currently looking for individuals who would be available on weekdays. Volunteers can help enhance police services, enabling police officers to respond more effectively to enforcement and policing priorities. Duties include Neighborhood and Business patrols, speed watch, vacation home checks, handicapped parking enforcement, VIN Inspections and more.

Volunteers must:

- Be at least eighteen (18) years of age;
- Possess a valid Nevada Driver's License and maintain a satisfactory driving record
- Never have been convicted of a felony (as well as no misdemeanor convictions in past two years);
- Successfully complete background investigation requirements;
- Be available on weekdays, approximately 10 hours a month.
