New Leash Law in Effect



The new Boulder City Leash Law is now in effect. Dog owners must keep their dogs on a leash in all public areas unless they are in a designated off-leash area, as approved by City Council. Designated off-leash areas include the two fenced dog parks at Veterans Memorial Park; North Escalante Park; the Linear Park along the drainage channel between Ville & Lake Mountain Drive; and designated outlying Desert Areas.

Dogs are also allowed off-leash in Wilbur Square during designated hours: 5:00-8:00 a.m. & 3:00-6:00 p.m. Off-leash dogs must be under voice command and in eyesight of someone 18 years or older at all times, and that person is responsible for cleaning up animal waste, for their pet's behavior or damages caused.


Other than the designated off-leash areas outlined above, dogs must be kept on a leash in all public areas including parks, sidewalks, walking paths, trails, the Desert Conservation Area and the Dry Lake.

Dogs (regardless of leash) are not allowed in Hemenway Park, on the golf courses, on fenced sports fields or sport courts, on the splash pad, on playgrounds or at the pool. All dogs must be licensed (due in January), spayed or neutered and up-to-date on vaccines. For more information, visit www.bcnv.org/dogpark.
