

R E S O L U T I O N N O. 942
A LIQUOR LICENSE FEE ADJUSTMENT

WHEREAS, Section 4-2-7 of the City Code has been amended to require the City Council to set the alcoholic liquor license fees by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the alcoholic liquor license fees have not been changed since the Boulder City, Nevada, Liquor Control Act was first adopted, which became effective September 8, 1969, with the exception of the Class D-2 license which was added December 6, 1978 by Ordinance #645 and fee set by Resolution #590, but the cost of administering the provisions of the Liquor Control Act have increased due to higher personnel salaries and benefits, increased costs for supplies and other required material;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Boulder City that Resolution No. 590 be repealed in its entirety and that the following license fees be established pursuant to Chapter 4-2-7 of the City Code:

Class "A"--Tavern License	\$ 900.00 per year
Class "A-1"--Tavern Limited License	240.00 per year
Class "B"--Cocktail Lounge License	1,200.00 per year
Class "B-1"--Cocktail Lounge Limited License	240.00 per year
Class "C"--Service Bar License	450.00 per year
Class "D"--Package License	600.00 per year
Class "D-1"--Package Limited License	150.00 per year
Class "D-2"--Package Special	240.00 per year
Class "E"--Import-Wholesale License	1,500.00 per year
Class "F"--Club License	300.00 per year
Class "F-1"--Club Limited License	240.00 per year
Class "G"--Special Event License	25.00 per day
Class "G-1"--Special Event Limited License	15.00 per day

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing license fees shall go into effect upon adoption of this Resolution, following a public hearing, which was held on April 26, 1983, except that the present annual license fees, which are being paid on a semi-annual basis, shall remain in effect for the license period January 1 through June 30, 1983.
